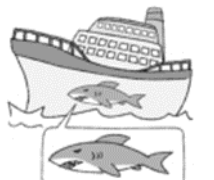
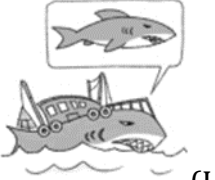

These days, food prices are going up in Taiwan. Luckily, a new way of shopping comes out. People call it group shopping. It may help you face higher prices and give you a way to try new foods from other places.

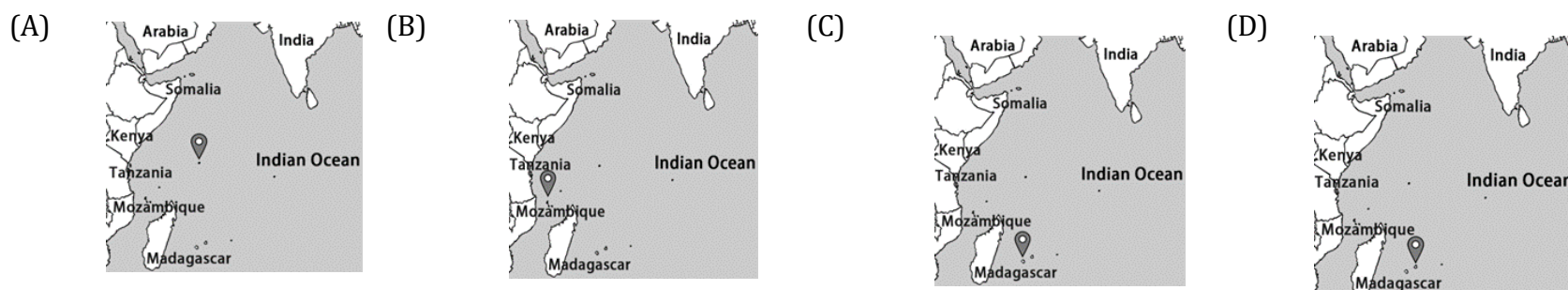

People love cat videos online, but these days a big bird catch people's eye; it's all because the way it eats. This big bird is Shoebill. When you see the shoebill for the first time, you may think it could be a relative of dinosaurs! The bird has a very large beak that can be up to 24 centimeters long, and that makes it have the third-largest beak in the bird world. In fact, scientists used to think it was a stork because of its giant beak and long, thin legs! But now they know it's more closely related to pelicans than storks.

The shoebill hunts at night and waits quietly in swamp water to catch living things swimming by. It eats lungfish, baby alligators, frogs, water snakes, and other life in or on water. The birds usually hunt in water with a lower level of oxygen because this type of water makes the fish and other animals in it to go up for air more often, making them easier targets for shoebills. The shoebill's beak has a sharp hook at the end that helps it kill animals for its food. The shoebill's feet with large, parted toes can let it stand on underwater plants.

Shoebills live in central Africa, and people can find them from Sudan to northern Zambia. It may be harder and harder to find them in the future because humans are destroying their homes and hunting these birds. There are only between 5,000 and 8,000 of these animals left in the world.

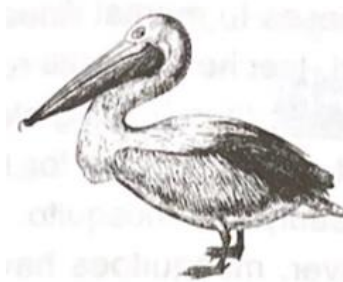
