Emperor Penguin Emperor Penguins are between 36 to 54 inches tall, and up to 88 pounds. Emperor Penguins live in Antarctica. It is one of the most difficult places to live on Earth. The Emperor Penguins stay together in a big group to keep warm, like a big hug. After the mommy penguins lay eggs on the ice, they go on a trip to hunt. The daddy penguins take care of the eggs. They can swim really deep, all the way down to 1,850 feet! And they can stay there for up to 20 minutes. They have to swim really fast and jump out of the water so they can get back onto the ice.	Little Blue Penguin Little Blue Penguins are between 13 and 15 inches tall, and 1.75 to 3 pounds. Little Blue Penguins live in New Zealand and Australia. So Little Blue Penguins might see people more often. Little Blue penguins work in much smaller groups. Usually, only about 10 Little Blue Penguins go hunting together at night time. They hunt for food in shallower water, so they can only swim down to about 230 feet and stay there for about 35 seconds. The Little Blue Penguins don't have to jump out of the water, they just walk onto the beach.

Kivalina is an small island town in Alaska. It is only 10 km², so you usually can't find it on a map. This small Arctic town is home to 400 Inuit people. However, these Inuit people will have to leave their home because the Chukchi Sea might cover the island by 2025.

But life now is difficult. Winters are getting warmer and warmer, the Arctic ice is melting, and the sea is rising. Because of these changes, it is harder for Inuit people to live by hunting and fishing than before. What's worse, the Arctic ice isn't thick enough to keep them safe from terrible wind and rain.

These Inuit people are angry because they think the oil and power company in Alaska brought all these troubles, but the town's people have to pay the price. It would cost hundreds of millions to move their town, and they have no idea where to get the money.
